Let's begin our study of God's VISION with some definitions.
How would YOU define the word VISION?


Keep this answer in mind as you look at how God made the world and mankind in the beginning. Specific verses have been chosen for you to focus on God's vision. Reading the verses before and after the selected verses will give you deeper understanding. This is what is called CONTEXT. It is an important concept in studying scripture. Verses have meaning based on what is around them. Try reading at least one of these in context, particularly if you are struggling to answer the questions.


 Read Genesis 1:26-31, making notes of what God does and how it affects Adam and Eve.

 Now, read Genesis 2:15-25, making the same notes.

 Based on your reading, describe Adam's relationship with God in the Garden.

 Now read Chapter 3:8-11

 How does that relationship change?

 What conclusions can you draw regarding the relationship God wants with mankind? What was His VISION for us?
