

## EXPLORER TUESDAY MORNING WATCH

Yesterday you looked at Adam and Eve and the relationship they had with God. Moving forward in history this morning you will look at Abram /Abraham. He started out as Abram, but God later changed his name to Abraham. Abraham lived a long full life (175 years) and 12 chapters in Genesis record his relationship with God.

Below you will see a number of individual verses. As you read them look for the action verbs – What did Abram/Abraham do? In some of the verses you might find more than one thing. Be sure to list all you find. If you have time and want more information read the verses in context (read the surrounding verses to get the full picture). It is always best to read the entire chapter, but due to time limitations this morning specific verses have been pulled out. You might find it interesting to read Genesis 12-25 to get the broad picture of Abraham. On my bunk time is a great opportunity.
