A tool is something that helps you do something.

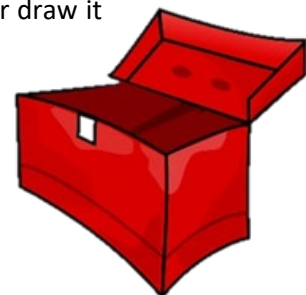
All week our theme verse has been Hebrews 12:2, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith."
