A tool is something that helps you do something.

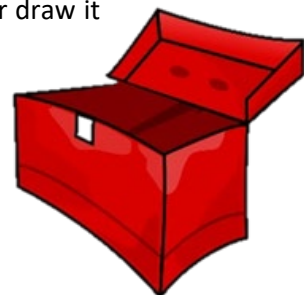
All week our theme verse has been Hebrews 12:2, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith."

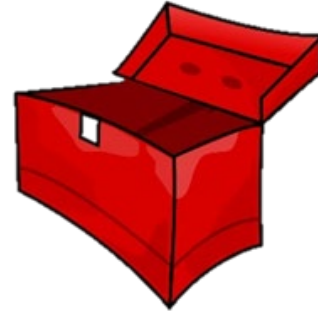
 What book do you think Jesus meant when He said it is written? Write or draw it in front of the toolbox down below.

Where did Jesus go to pray and who prayed with Him?



Turn to Luke, which is on the other side of Mark. Read Luke 5:16.



How frequently did Jesus pray and where did he often go to pray?



Turn one chapter over. Read Luke 6:12-13.



Where did Jesus choose to pray and how long did Jesus pray?



After spending time in prayer, what did Jesus do?



Turn back to the book of Mark. Read Mark 14:32-36



Where did Jesus go to pray and who did He take with Him?



What did Jesus ask the Father?



What would Jesus do no matter what?

📖 Lastly, turn over to the book of Luke. Read Luke 23:44-46

✍️ Where is Jesus and who did Jesus call out to as He died?

# CHALLENGER FRIDAY MORNING WATCH

Yesterday, we saw that as the crowd was stoning Stephen to death, that he gazed into Heaven and saw Jesus. His eyes were fixed on Jesus as he left this life and went to be with Him. - A Application. ✎ Make it personal to you. What is God saying to you? How can I use this in my life?
- P Prayer. Ask God to work in your life, show you where you need to make changes, use this truth in your life.

## EXPLORER FRIDAY MORNING WATCH

How was Timothy equipped?

Timothy was called to preach and teach the gospel just as we are.

God’s will for us is to glorify Him and to be ambassadors sharing the gospel.

How has God equipped you to do His will?

It is not easy to speak out, to be different, to stand for the truth; but God has equipped you and will continue to equip you. Use today’s memory verse to remind yourself of this fact.
