When you believe in Jesus and become His close friend, you love Jesus. You want to learn more about Jesus so you fix your eyes on Jesus, focusing on Him just like our theme verse says. Before Adam and Eve disobeyed God, they fixed their eyes on Him. They spent time with Him every evening in the Garden. Sin (disobeying God) made seeing God, spending time with Him, impossible. But some day we will return to perfect vision, seeing God, spending time with Him. This will happen when we are in heaven with Jesus.

TRAILBLAZER SATURDAY MORNING WATCH



PRAY: Ask God to help you keep your eyes on Him.

It's Saturday, the final day of Camp Cedarbrook 2020! This is your last morning at camp to start your day with God. Our prayer is that you will choose to carve out time each day at home investing in your relationship with the Lord. This morning, we are going to focus on God's VISION of the future.

Memory Verse: Hebrews 12:2 "Let us fix our eyes upon Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith..."

- When you return home, what circumstances will be waiting for you?
- Past today, what does your future look like?
- Have you thought about the far future? Have you thought about heaven?
- What do you think heaven will be like?
- What do you think it will be like to see God?

If you are not sure, that is okay. The Bible explains why you may not be sure:

1 Corinthians 13:12 (CEV) Now all we can see of God is like a cloudy picture in a mirror. Later we will see him face to face. We don't know everything, but then we will, just as God completely understands us.

We began this week in Genesis, the first book of the Bible. Remember that Adam and Eve had a relationship with God with no barriers. That's how it will be in heaven.

While Jesus walked on the earth, He informed us that in heaven our relationship would be like it was in the beginning.

John 14:2-3 (NKJV) 2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

Let's read more about heaven. Go to Revelation in your Bible; it's the last book.

EXPLORER SATURDAY MORNING WATCH

All week we have been talking about “fixing our eyes on Jesus”. We started with the perfect relationship Adam and Eve originally had with God as seen in Genesis, the first book of the Bible. This morning we are going to look at the relationship we will have with God in eternity as seen in Revelation, the last book of the Bible. From beginning to end the Bible is the record of man’s relationship with God. From beginning to end it is God’s call to us with examples of people who did or did not “fix their eyes” on God or Jesus.
