

COVID POLICY

1. Masks are optional but not required.
2. We will enforce 3 ft distancing inside and outside - catch up lines, activities, etc.
3. Size of cohort - not setting specific size
4. Temperature will be checked daily and recorded by DD during Morning Watch catch up
5. Disinfection of equipment will be done after each use by wiping the equipment down with antibacterial wipes.
6. Hand sanitizer (or washing with soap and water for 20 seconds) - required before each meal and at the beginning and end of each activity and Bible Ex.
7. Cabins will be disinfected a minimum of two times daily (during Capers and after showers). All surfaces in the bathroom and other areas that are touched frequently will be wiped down with antibacterial wipes. - all handles, countertops, mirrors, towel dispensers, etc.
8. Sleeping arrangements - bunks that are next to each other must also be opposite (one head near wall, next bunk over head is toward middle of room)
9. Registration - drive through. Parents will be asked to stay in the car except to unload luggage at the cabin. They will not be allowed to go into the cabins.
10. Tuck shop - 2 people on platform shopping and 3 ft distancing in waiting line
11. We highly recommend that campers do not come to camp immediately after a mission trip, etc. Campers should not come to camp if they have any signs of any illness.
12. All participants must sign the COVID Disclaimer.
